Recently, seven-year-old Eli completed serial casting treatment at La Rabida, working his way through 13 casts over the course of just 14 weeks. An incredibly smart, caring boy, Eli has Diplegic Cerebral Palsy that affects both of his legs. The muscles in the back of his ankles are most affected, making his ankles very tight - like he was always pointing his toes. During serial casting, Eli's physical therapist applied a series of casts to increase his range of motion by progressively lengthening the shortened muscles in his legs.

During the course of his treatment, Eli and his mom never missed an appointment, even on the coldest day of the year! The pair were committed to the process, followed all directions, and worked extremely hard on his home exercise program every week. All this hard work paid off; Eli thrived with serial casting. 




