Then and Now: A Patient Remembers La Rabida

In the 1970s, Michael Groves stayed at La Rabida for six months to be treated for juvenile rheumatoid arthritis. As a young boy, he suffered a lot of pain in his knees and often woke up with painful knees, especially when it rained. His older brother even helped him with exercises they learned at La Rabida to relieve the pain.

While at La Rabida, Michael recalls how his room overlooked Jackson Harbor and how he became friends with a little girl named Sadie. Sadie would only eat if Michael was with her, so the nurses would bring Sadie into his room, or he would be taken to hers for meals. Michael's primary doctor at the time was Dr. Grossman, whom he thought was amazing because he knew all the kids' names and continued to see him for several years after he was discharged.

Today Michael is a council supervisor at an oil refinery and gives back to La Rabida regularly out of gratitude for his wonderful care.

Dr. Radhika Peddinti, who leads our Sickle Cell program, was recently appointed to the governor's Advisory Council on Financing and Access to Sickle Cell Disease Treatment and Other High-Cost Drugs and Treatment – that's a long name! Governor Pritzker signed an executive order at La Rabida earlier this year that established the council to provide leadership for and collaborate with those working to make sickle cell disease treatments and other high-cost drugs and treatments accessible. Dr. Peddinti will also help to advise the Illinois Department of Healthcare and Family Services on the development of payment models and financing approaches for sickle cell disease

treatment and other high-cost drugs and treatments that support equitable access and contribute to national efforts to formulate solutions.

35th Annual La Rabida Golf Classic


