Exploring and trying new things is part of how we help our patients, like Edward, who has Down syndrome and was born with congenital heart disease. Both of his sisters are La Rabida patients as well, visiting our Chicago Children's Diabetes Center.

"We were here for an appointment when it first started, and we were surprised to see the set up," said Tiffanie. "Every year we register and are excited to see the program come back!"

Many of La Rabida's patients and families face healthcare disparities and inequities

that make getting quality, specialty care difficult. Things like housing insecurity, lack of health insurance, language barriers, transportation difficulties, and food insecurity also have an impact on healing, growth, and development. "When we are talking with our families food insecurity is a big part of the conversation,"

said Care Coordinator, Ana Camacho. "When we are able to offer a support for more

than just their medical needs, you see relief and hope in their eyes." Since 2021, La Rabida has partnered with Just Roots, a local organization with two community farms supplying fruits and vegetables for our families to take home.

They also share kid-friendly cooking demonstrations in our outpatient clinic once a month. The food and education this partnership provides are resources our families need to ensure better health outcomes.
